Security Forum Update

The Security Forum initiated work on its new Open FAIR[™] Body of Knowledge Update Project, aiming to identify updates needed to ensure alignment with the NIST Cybersecurity Framework (CST) 2.0. The Security Forum ZTA Working Group also announced the Company Review of the Zero Trust Commandments Standard (which closes Jun. 30, 2024) and concluded the Forum Review of the Security Principles for Architecture Standard, which is expected to have its Company Review announced in the coming weeks.

The Open Group Technology Forum Update

The Open Trusted Technology Forum continued working on updates and enhancements to the Open Trusted Technology Provider™ Standard (O-TTPS), working through feedback and input received during the Supply Chain Security Concerns Survey that it distributed in 2023. Forum Director John Linford also represented the OTTF at the Spring Software and Supply Chain Assurance Forum and MITRE System of Trust Community Meeting.

The Assured Dependability Work Group Update

The Assured Dependability Work Group continued developing the Open Dependability through Assuredness[™] (O-DA) Framework, Version 2.01. This content has been converted to AsciiDoc and is the process of being included in the Work Group's GitLab site so that future iterations may utilize this development approach.
